A few things you need to know about what happens AFTER your audition:

POSTING OF CAST LIST:

The cast list for the show will be posted on our Facebook page (https://www.facebook.com/ocpnc/). We will email each individual auditionee with casting information. Please check your email and our Facebook page regularly during the week after your audition.

PERFORMANCE DATES AND LOCATION

The Music Man performances will be July 25-28 at Cedar Ridge High School in Hillsborough. Performances will be at 7:00 PM July 25-27 and at 2pm on July 28.

PARTICIPATION FEE & ATTACHED FORMS:

If you are cast in the show you will need **bring the following items with you to our 1**st **full cast meeting on Monday, 5/13 at 6:30 PM at New Hope Camp and Conference Center**:

- Code of Conduct and Parent Participation forms completed online via our website, ocpnc.com, or brought to the meeting with signature.
- Your participation fee can be paid by Venmo (@ocpnc), check, cash or credit card
- Your Parent/Cast Volunteer Sheet mark which committee(s) you will help with.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL the above MUST be turned in at the 1st full cast meeting on May 13th or special arrangements must be made with an OCP Board Member on or by that date or you will not be allowed to begin rehearsals.

VOLUNTEER SHEET:

All parents of children under the age of 16 and all cast members 16 and above are expected, when cast, to sign up for a volunteer committee and volunteer at least eight hours of time to helping prepare for the show. Please read the Volunteer Sheet carefully so that you know what the expectations are for participation within each Volunteer Committee.

CONFLICTS:

Please ensure you have provided ALL conflicts info on your audition form. This is very important information needed by our director in order to cast the show and to set a rehearsal schedule. Conflicts added after casting may, sadly, result in the loss of your role in the show.
